SWCHC is a federally qualified health center recognized by the Joint Commission as a Primary Care Medical Home Certified Organization. SWCHC is dedicated to providing high quality, accessible medical, dental and behavioral health services to individuals and families in the Greater Bridgeport area especially the uninsured, underserved and homeless populations.

From the beginning, in 1976 a group of concerned and committed citizens representing the City of Bridgeport, Bridgeport Housing Authority and other neighborhood agencies formed the West End Neighborhood Advisory Council to address the need for medical and dental services. The Advisory Council submitted an application to the Department of Health, Education and Welfare to provide services in their impoverished neighborhoods. In August 1977 the Advisory Council received the three-year "Notice of Grant Award" and the Health Center became a reality.

At the end of the three-year funding cycle the Advisory Council emerged as the Board of Directors with sole fiduciary responsibilities of the newly incorporated Health Center. In 1978, the services were relocated from PT Barnum housing complex to the refurbished St. Stephen's School on Bird Street. On August 1980, Southwest Community Health Center was incorporated as a not-for-profit entity.

SWCHC has expanded their services into seven locations including five school based health centers offering a full range of comprehensive medical, dental, behavioral health and intensive outpatient substance abuse treatment services.





Great Oaks Bridgeport is a comprehensive 6th through 12th grade publicly funded charter school dedicated to academic achievement with individualized care and support to meet the needs of our diverse community. With over 650 students, Great Oaks Charter School is set apart by our commitment to career and college readiness supported through our passion for the social and emotional support of all students.

Our unique partnership with AmeriCorps provides
Fellows dedicating a year of service benefiting our
students with additional support in English Language
Arts, math, and mentorship delivering on our mission
to address the inequities found in many traditional
settings. Our AmeriCorps Fellows go through rigorous
training in community building, relationship
development, and instructional support. Many of our
AmeriCorps Fellows develop into teachers serving our
school after their AmeriCorps commitment.


